WHAT ARE THE JOB REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NURSE INTERNSHIP POSITION?

Nursing students must attend an accredited nursing program and currently be enrolled. We will also accept existing SMH employees that are attending a nursing program and in good standing.

WHAT DEPARTMENTS CAN NURSE INTERN HIRE INTO?

Medical/Surgical and Emergency Department

WHAT IS THE HIRING PROCESS FOR NURSE INTERNS?

Positions will be posted on our website and candidates will be screened for areas of interest. Department managers will interview candidates and offer positions.

HOW WILL YOU BE ON-BOARDED?

All hires will attend hospital orientation. The manager will connect with the hire to orient to the department and assign them to a preceptor. The manager will communicate their schedule and expectations.
